### Harrow Arena

Things to remember when using Harrow Arena:

- Every person entering must complete the Health Screening Questionnaire prior to entering (every time)
- Every person entering must be recorded on the SCPGHA Tracking Sheet by a team member
- Arena access will remain through the front door
- Face masks are always mandatory inside the arena and must cover the nose and mouth except when on the ice (when the helmet comes off the masks goes on)
- All participants must come fully dressed except for skates, helmets, and goalie pads. There will be a designated spot inside to put on skates and helmets.
- Follow all signage once inside the arena
- Always maintain physical distancing of at least 2m from others
- No food or beverage will be allowed on-site, except for a filled water bottle/ice user
- One parent/guardian may attend to help with tying of skates BUT must enter and exit at the same time as the individual and remain in the arena for the duration in the designated spectator viewing area (lobby and limited bowl seating)
- Should a parent/guardian leave the premises, return entry will not be permitted
- Participants will not be able to enter the facility until 20 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled ice time and must vacate the premises 15 minutes after each session has ended
- If a participant arrives after the 20-minute access window, the doors will remain locked and access may be denied
- Public washrooms will be available
- Exiting the facility
  - Lobby guest/spectators will exit through the doors to the right of the canteen (south-east door to the parking lot)
  - User groups accessing the dressing rooms will exit through the double set of doors off the dressing room hallway leading to the tennis court (North doors)
